Purpose

To provide guidance on promoting sustainable forms of transportation to and from the Northey Street City Farm site for all workers, visitors and members.

Policy

1. The Farm will provide:
 - a. secure bicycle parking facilities,
 - b. information about public transport, bicycle and pedestrian access on all promotional materials,
 - c. access on Farm computers to the Translink website for workers, visitors and members wishing to plan their public transport journeys,
 - d. information on public transport options and bike options on its advertising for events.
2. The Farm will provide a limited number of car parking spaces on a 'first come' basis:
 - a. 14 car parks for staff and regular volunteers,
 - b. two car parks for nursery customers.
3. Unfortunately, The Farm is not able to guarantee the availability of car parking for any person, whether they be worker, visitor or member. Car parking is not permitted outside the designated parking areas under BCC by-laws.
4. The Farm will maintain access for delivery vehicles bringing supplies to the Nursery.
